We will welcome the Christ Child with festive Christmas Eve worship on December 24<sup>th</sup> with 4 services. The 3 p.m. service is designed for those who do not wish to drive at night and those who have other Christmas Eve plans. The 3 p.m. & 6 p.m. services will feature the "Awaken" Worship Team from our contemporary worship providing the music. The 8:30 p.m. & 11 p.m. services will feature traditional organ and other instruments. All 4 services will be preceded by 20 minutes of pre-service music and all will include your favorite Christmas Carols, Holy Communion and a Candlelight Celebration. 
### Orange Park Farmer & Arts Market Team




#### Shoe Boxes for the Less Fortunate


Advent's Social Ministry Board is sponsoring Shoes Boxes again this year for the less fortunate in our community. The boxes or items can be placed in the Fellowship Hall on the card table near the door. If you can donate to this cause we will need the following by Sunday, December 3<sup>rd</sup> - Shoe boxes can be any that you may have at home (cardboard or plastic). They may be purchased from Dollar Stores. Once they are filled, please wrap them (lids separately) and labeled; Boy 2-4 Years Old, 5-9 Years Old, 10-14 Years Old or Girl with one of the same age groups. Include some of the following items: **TOYS!** Age appropriate like a beautiful doll, a deflated soccer ball with pump, or a plush stuffed animal, cars, puzzles, jump ropes, etc. School Supplies pencils, pens, crayons, notebooks, coloring books, etc. **Hygiene** Items such as toothbrushes, toothpaste, bar soap, washcloths, combs, etc. **ACCESSORIES** such as socks, hats, t-shirts, flip-flops, hair bands, sunglasses, etc. **Younger Children**: Stickers, picture books, blocks, finger puppets, pages of colorful stickers. **Older Children**: Small tools, tape measures, sewing kits, fabric squares, etc; and needles; solar calculators, rulers, scissors; jewelry; deodorant.
