
- Discuss the Children's sermon on the ride home from church

- Help your children memorize key verses (John 3:16, Ephesians 2:8-9, the Lord's Prayer)


Bible classes will begin again at the end of summer, at the start of the regular school year. Look for future announcements about the start of the next school year.


HELP US WITH YOUTH MINISTRY


